



G. BLAWCET-2023 Structure


The Test is designed to evaluate the candidate's General Knowledge, Mental Ability, Current Affairs and Aptitude to pursue the study of Law. The Test consists of 5 Parts. Part-A, B, C and D will comprise of 75 questions of multiple choice questions and Part-E will contain 5 subjective questions. All questions (except Part-D) will be bilingual (English and Hindi both). Total number of questions will be 80 and the duration of the test is 120 minutes. Maximum marks are 100. **There shall be no negative marking.**

H. BLAWCET-2023 Results

(i) **Evaluation:** Every care will be taken to avoid the errors in evaluation, checking, scrutiny, tabulation and ranking. Hence, the request for re-totaling or reevaluation or personal identification of scripts will not be entertained.

(ii) **Ranking:** The candidates will be ranked in the order of merit based on the marks obtained in BLAWCET-2023. Separate ranking lists will be prepared amongst the candidates for admissions to LL.B (3 years) and Pre-Law (5 years). In case of tie the relative rank will be decided as mentioned below:-

a. If there is a tie in total marks, the marks obtained in Part-C of the entrance test will be considered for awarding the rank and if the tie still persists marks obtained in Part- A shall be taken into consideration.

b. If the tie still persists they may be bracketed together for the purpose of ranking and seniority in age may be considered at the time of admission.

(iii) Rank obtained in BLAWCET-2023 is valid for admission into 3 year/5 year Law Courses, as the case may be, for the academic year 2023-24 only.
